Examined seacocks & connections and found them good. New hopper valves has been fitted in stem tube
 The donkey boiler has had a few patches fitted round the bottom & is in a good condition
 The 2 main boilers and steam domes were found to be in a good condition
 Examined safety valves slide valves high and low pressed cylinders & Pistons, and pumps and found them in a good condition
 Examined crankshaft & found it in a good condition
 The safety valves were found to blow off at 75 lb per square inch

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe working condition and is in my opinion eligible to have the notification L M C. 285 recorded in the Register Book
