REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Re-metalling.

The yellow metal sheathing has been stripped off the bottom; the bottom examined, recaulked and resheathed with yellow metal over felt. Nearly the whole of the forecastle deck renewed of 3" yellow pine fastened with galvanized iron nut and screw bolts.
