Examined Seacocks & connections & found them good.  
Examined 2 main boilers & superheater. The Superheater has been strengthened by an angle iron appears to be safe. The aft bottom end of port boiler near blow off pipe has been patched. Several parts have had to be caulked. The boilers appear to be in a safe working condition.  
Examined crankshaft pumps cylinders & slides & found them in a good condition.  
Examined safety valves & found them (lever & weights) in good working condition for 75 lbs per sq inch.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe working condition and in my opinion eligible to have the notification BS & MS 3.85 recorded in the Register Book.
