Examined Sea cocks & connections & found them good. The stern tube has been relined. The tail shaft was found to be sound.

Examined 2 main and one donkey boiler and found them in a good condition.

Examined the Safety valves, slide valves, high and low pressure cylinders and pumps & found them in a good condition.

Examined crankshaft and found it in a good condition.

The vessel has left without having the safety valves tested.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— *As far as seen the machinery of this vessel is in a safe working condition and eligible in my opinion to have the notification L. M. C. 85 recorded provided the safety valves are found to blow off at 65 lbs pressure.*
