Examined Seacocks & connections & found them good.

The outer end of the tailstaff liner (3") was found to be slack. On drawing the staff the slackness was found to extend 2" beyond the outside edge of the lignum vitae. The staff has been warmed & soft solder run between the liner & the staff.

Examined the main boiler & horizontal dome & found them good. Several small stays & a few plates have been renewed.

The donkey boiler is disconnected from its steam pipe & can not be used.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe working condition and is in my opinion eligible to have the notification B.S. 2. 86 recorded in the Register Book
 (State clearly what alteration, if any, is suggested to be made in the existing notification of the vessel's machinery in the Register Book, consequent upon this survey.)
