Examined the main boiler and found it in a good condition. A patch on the shell and a few rivets have been renewed.

A new tailshaft and a new white metal liner have been fitted.

The safety valves were found to blow off at 35 lb.

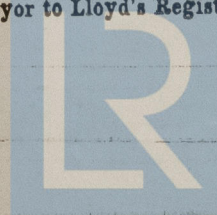
