The safety valves have been adjusted by the Board of Trade Surveyor on no opportunity has subsequently been afforded since then as steam has never been got up except on Sundays or during very late or very early hours.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the machinery of this vessel is in a safe working condition and eligible in my opinion to have the modification B-S. 5-86 recorded in the Register Book
