REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS

This vessel was placed in dry dock, the yellow metal sheathing removed, (it being stated that she had not been to sea since last metalled in 83) The Bottom & sides caulked from keel to gunwale. (but no opportunity was afforded for testing caulking or other examination) and the bottom sheathed with yellow metal.

I am given to understand that this vessel is bought by the Orient Steam Nav Co, together with the Peterborough for the purpose of being converted into coal hulks at Diego Garcia or Aden.
