Examined Scavengers & connections & found them good. The tailshaft was examined & found good in August 1884. See London report 44068.
 Examined the donkey boiler & two main boilers & 2 domes and found them good.
 The high pressure piston ring has been renewed. The high & low pressure cylinders & slides, the safety valves, crankshaft & pumps were found to be in a good condition.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The machinery of this vessel is in a safe working condition and eligible in my opinion to have the notification B & L M. C. 7. 86 recorded in the Register Book
