The bottom has been examined and coated. A 14" coir towline supplied.
An anchor has now been placed on board in lieu of one ^{bower} reported to have
been lost — marks on anchor are 34-3-10 6006 10.80 LPH. B&T. 32-5-2-0
6-3-0

from which it appears that the weight ex. stock is ^{cwts. grs. lbs.} 34-3-10 and that the anchor is a tested anchor - see also Owners' letter attached hereto. One bower anchor was bent; the central portion of the shank has been cut away, leaving a short length at each end, and a heavier central portion introduced with a proper V weld at each end - making the weight of the shank about $2\frac{1}{2}$ cwts. more than before. The weight ex. stock of this anchor was ^{cwts. grs. lbs.} 32-1-18 - its present weight ex. stock therefore would be about ^{cwts. grs. lbs.} 34-3-18. It will be seen however that while the shank is heavier than before, the arms have not been increased in strength to correspond with the shank. This anchor moreover has not been retested. The collective weight of the bower anchors on board is ^{PT} 211 1/2 tons.
