Two new half Crank shafts fitted - four new half main bearing brasses, new bottom end brasses to each engine - also new feet welded on to each connecting rod.

Main and donkey boiler safety valves adjusted to respective working pressures of 80 lbs. & 55 lbs. per square inch. Engine tried under steam & found satisfactory.

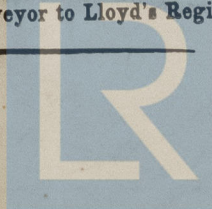
