The vessel was tilted & the propeller partly exposed & found about 2 feet broken off one blade through bolt holes where a patch had previously been fitted and about 1 foot off an other blade.  
 These defects do not endanger the vessels safety.  
 It is intended to fit a new propeller on the vessels return.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the machinery of this vessel is in a safe working condition and eligible in my opinion to remain as classed.
