REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Special Survey No 2 SS 801-84

This vessel was placed in dry dock the bottom examined cleaned & coated. The chain cables were inspected last March. so that it was considered requisite to range them. The masts, spars and general equipment examined. The whole of the ceiling having been removed from the tank tops the tanks were tested by water pressure and found tight and in good order inside and outside. The engine and boiler room bilges and the forward and after peaks were cleaned and cement washed and are in good order. The tween decks and sides of holds are in good order.

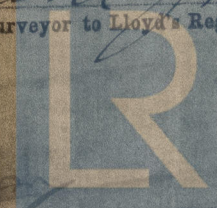
