REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR

This vessel was continued A.1. 9 years from July/78. The vessel therefore to retain a character in the Register Book should be subjected to a special survey according to the character that might be desired. The Master however states that it is not desired to proceed with such survey. The yellow metal sheathing has been stripped off the bottom - and the vessel reported to have been recaulked from keel to gunwale. The bottom resheathed with yellow metal which I understand is over felt.
