REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Condition

This Vessel has been examined in the Canal Dry Dock. The bottom found in good order, has been cleaned & painted. The rudder has been lifted and bushed. Several bent stanchions in the hold and tween decks have now been straightened, and some holes in the bow in way of the main beams have been riveted up.
