Main boilers examined internally & externally & found to be in good condition. Safety valves in good condition & loaded with a lever weight to 75 lbs. A new donkey boiler was fitted in Sept last. See annexed report.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:--

The boilers being now in good & safe working condition renders the vessel eligible in our opinion to remain as classed & have the notification B.S. 11.87 recorded provided that the boilers are again examined within 12 mths. as per rule.
