REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Condition of Raised Class.

This vessel was seen lying afloat in the East India Dock. Several timber boards & ceiling lifted in various parts of the vessel, all the iron bolts in topside planking now renewed with bolts of yellow metal in order to entitle the vessel to an additional year for metal fastening per paragraph 2.

The deck repaired temporarily for the voyage by renewing ten deck planks of pitch pine & caulking the deck in way of galleys in midship Deck House [See Secretary's letters attached hereto]

The owner propose to renew the deck on her return to this country.
