REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Completion of S.S. No. 3.*
See Southampton Report No. 2792 dated 5th January 1889. which states that to complete the S.S. No 3 the midships part of the hold from 5th pillar before main hatchway to after part of waterway, & parts, & the outside of the vessel above loadline to be examined.
These parts of the hold have now been completely cleared of ceiling, & all the scale or rust has been chipped or beaten off the iron surfaces. The cement has been examined, & repaired where necessary. The deck, rigging, equipment generally &c. have been examined, also the vessel outside, above the light line.
The iron surfaces have been recrated, & the ceiling relaid, the greater part thereof being new.
Chain cables changed & found complete.
