REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage

This vessel when coming up the River Thames on the 25<sup>th</sup> January 1889, came into collision with a dredger, & received damage to one plate in the 4<sup>th</sup> strake below the sheer—on the port side forward.

The damaged portion has now been cut out, fitted with new piece, & covered with inside doubting piece well riveted.
