REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Special Survey

This vessel has now been placed in dry dock & prepared for survey by the removal of ceiling, considerably a piece of the hull, the cement split out there required, so as to manure the bolt heads

The windlass manumend & the chain cables lashed and found complete

Masts, spars, & rigging generally, overhauled & made good, the fore topmast, fore top gallant mast, & main yard renewed

The yellow metal sheathing has been stripped off the bottom, dubbed down, recaulked & resheathed with yellow metal on felt as before.
