REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Condition This vessel has now been placed in dry dock, madder rebushed, the bottom cleaned & scraped.

Small repairs have been done to deck & deck work, to the ceiling in the hold - part of which has been renewed - & to the deck plate alongside boiler casing in way of the wind pipe. This plate, which was worn thin, has been doubled, & a new piece of connecting angle bar fitted.
