See Hull report No 7067 dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 1889  
in which it is stated that the bowsprit is broken inside of the Knight-heads  
The bowsprit has now been taken out & the two fractured  
plates replaced by new: & in addition a diagonal plate about ten  
feet in length has been riveted in in way of the Knight heads  
The heel of the main mast was also found to be somewhat  
buckled & crushed up & has now been fitted with a steel doubling  
plate

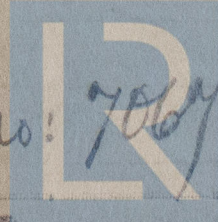
