REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Annual Survey.

This vessel was placed in Dry Dock when the Bottom which was found in good and sound condition was cleaned & re-coated. The Rudder was lifted and the Rudder joints re-bushed. Three Bulwark plates on port side abreast of main beam, found damaged, were cut out and replaced by new; one length of main rail in way of same was also renewed and the chain plates on this side, with the exception of the two foremost ones, were renewed and repaired as required.
