The after hatch side coamings removed & faired and new angle irons fitted. Steering gear aft refitted. Port life boat renewed and starboard boat repaired, Bridge deck recaulked, Several rivets in water way in way of port life boat renewed. One plate at bridge front starboard side renewed; & several glasses in saloon & chart house renewed. The deck aft (iron) caulked in several places. Several ventilators renewed and sundry small damage made good.
