REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Damage repairs*

This vessel has been examined in the Victoria docks (afloat) with a view to complete repairs in accordance with London report 51361. The following has now been done:

The main deck scupper on port side near the front of raised quarter deck has been removed, made good and refitted, the wooden casings round all the scuppers have been removed and scuppers repaired where necessary.

The covering board on main deck at front of raised quarter deck has been recaulked. Main deck round no 2 Hatchway recaulked.

A new jolly boat has been placed on board.

A new anchor (port bow) has now been placed on board with certificate of test of which the following are particulars:— No of certificate 12968
