REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Change of Owners

Vessel placed in dry dock, clipped down from gunwale to keel & recoated; Bottom outside in good condition. Rudder lifted and rebushed, & a shoe fitted on back. The cement found worn in several places has been renewed. Deck house of iron has been repaired. New hatches fitted to main hatch. The main deck aft is pieced in front of quarter deck, but otherwise in good condition. New planks have been placed on board to renew these during the voyage.
