 This vessel has been visited afloat in the Victoria and Royal Albert Docks for the purpose of examining the fastenings and coverings to the steam which pipes referred to in a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Auckland under date 18/7/91.

New galvanised iron chains and covers of a suitable description have now been fitted to the steam which pipes along the port side of nos. 2 & 3 hatchways.

The main deck plating has now been scaled & coated, and the forecabin, bridge and poop decks rescaulked.

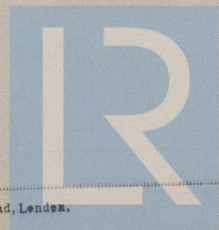
General Observations, Opinion as to Class, Recommendation, &c.:
