In order to place her in an efficient condition, 5 plates have been removed where broken or indented & new frames in the way of these plates have been repaired. Wood work in cabin on star' side removed & afterwards replaced

owners do not intend to hold the special survey hol on this vessel just yet - this being the busy season in the coal trade
