REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage Repair

This vessel is stated to have been in collision with the S.S. "Ebro" & to have received damage to the starboard quarter abreast the after hatchway. Repairs to this damage have now been done as under:
 Two plates in quarter deck side renewed, two frames in way of same part renewed, & two others doubled: one plate on quarter deck stump renewed, & one taken out fairied & re-riveted; tie plate on each side in way of hatchway fairied; bulwarks & rails made good; angle iron casing on starboard side of after hatchway renewed & the half beams refastened. Deck plank & waterway removed for these repairs now relaid, part being covered on account of damage & recaulked.
