This vessel has been placed in Dry Dock, the whole of the Metal sheathing stripped off, and the bottom dulled down, re-caulked, and the same tested and found good, bottom re-sheathed with yellow Metal on felt.
The owners desire that the above work should be credited to the next special survey.
