The vessel was placed in dry dock when the bottom which was found in good and sound condition, was cleaned and re-coated.

The chain cables, viz: 300 fath 5 1/16 were ranged out and found complete and in good order.

This vessel is now, as far as can be seen, in good & efficient condition and I would respectfully submit that she is eligible to remain as classed, viz: 100 A1 and to have fresh date of Survey 6.92 recorded in the Register Book.
