All the requirements of the Rules for the Special Survey No. 3 have been complied with and the vessel being now, as far as can be seen, in good and efficient condition, I would respectfully submit that she is eligible to remain as classed, with the notation "S.S. TONGARIRO No. 3-92" and fresh date of Survey 6.92

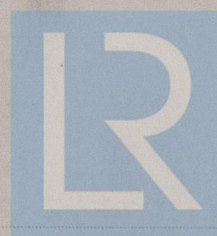
