4 Frames entirely removed & renewed -

To facilitate the removal of these frames, the rivetting in 2 plates in the 2nd strake below the outer strake, ^{partly} loosened, & one plate in the 3rd strake below the above removed, these ^{were afterwards} rivets renewed & the plate replaced -

2 Deck beams repaired, 1 Boiler stay to ship's side renewed
20 ft of main deck stringer bar, & several legs renewed -
1 Side stringer plate renewed, & one cut back 4 feet,
2 doubling plates over these removed & replaced -

Other Repairs

5 Indentations in various parts of the shell faired,
one plate in E strake 2nd from stem starboard side renewed
A half round iron rubbing strip fitted on the starboard side; this is to prevent undue wear & tear on this side when at the usual dis-charging berth -
