REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Condition & Damage Repairs

This steamer was placed in dry dock, the bottom examined cleaned & coated. Damage Repairs— in consequence of a collision with the S/S "Capulet" at Barrow Pier on the 25/6/93 one plate in the Fore Berthing (upper corner) renewed, 1 plate faired in place. one length of stringer bar renewed, 14 ft of waterway 7x3 renewed, 7 stanchions & rails to refit, 1 socket to do to renew & iron moulding on upper edge of plating.
