The timber boards and ceiling hatches as required by the Rules lifted from the main to the mizen masts, the timber in this range cleaned out & the cement and ironwork examined and found in good condition

To complete S.S. h^o 2 - with the exception of the examination of the cement and ironwork from main to mizen masts the whole of the requirements of this survey remain to be carried out.
