State clearly the cause of Repairs, if any, and, in detail, the nature and extent of Examinations and subsequent Repairs. Repairs on account of Damage (the cause of which must be stated) should be separated from Repairs due to other causes; and besides being detailed in the body of the report, should be summarised in the form shown below. Whenever the replacement of Anchors, Chains, or Hawsers is reported, the particulars of weight or size and test of the articles should be clearly stated, and also the weight or size, &c., required by the Rules, together with the vessel's Equipment Letter, if any. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.

REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Annual Survey.

Steel and bottom examined in dry dock, found the outside frame of the rudder broken through opposite to the top pintle, and the inner frame fractured just above the 2<sup>nd</sup> pintle. -  
Now done. The rudder unstipped, plating of same removed, a new upper part of frame forged and welded to the original, pintles overhauled, new plating fitted to the rudder, and the rudder refitted in place. - Bottom cleaned & recoated.

SUMMARY OF DAMAGE REPAIRS: - Plates, Faired or Repaired; Frames, ditto. Plates, Renewed; Frames, ditto. Other Repairs Rudder rep &amp; repaired.
