Periodical Surveys, when held, must be reported in detail and serially in the terms of the Rules. State clearly the cause of Repairs, if any, and, in detail, the nature and extent of Examinations and subsequent Repairs. Repairs to account of Damage (the cause of which must be stated) should be separated from Repairs due to other causes; and besides being detailed in the body of the report, should be summarised in the form shown below. Whenever the replacement of Anchors, Chains, or Hawsers is reported, the particulars of weight or size and test of the articles should be clearly stated, and also the weight or size, &c., required by the Rules, together with the vessel's Equipment letter, if any. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.

REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Part 4th Special Survey.
At owners request, examined bottom of vessel which was in good condition and has now been recoated.
Saw Captain and also called on owners in reference to the 4th Special Survey which is now overdue but no facilities have been afforded for making this survey and the owners state that the survey must be deferred until vessel returns.
To complete the survey all the requirements of the Rule should be done, with the exception of the dry docking of the vessel.
