The lumber boards and ceiling hatches in excess of the requirements of the Rules lifted from the fore end of the main hatchway to 3 ft abaft the tanks, cement and ironwork in this range examined, cement repaired in places where necessary and ceiling part renewed in way of main hatchway. The after peak examined sealed and painted. Pumps examined.

Vessel placed in dry dock bottom examined scraped and painted.
