If the Survey is not complete state what arrangements have been made for its completion? Completed.

Examined Main & Donkey Boilers internally & externally & Safety valves, also cylinders, Pistons, Slide Valves, Pumps & Condenser, Sea & Bilge connections, Crank, Thrust, Tunnel & Propeller shafts, propeller and fastenings. Found six screwed stays in Main Boiler leaking, a patch at bottom seam of Donkey Boiler furnace leaking & propeller shafting corroded at end of after liner. Otherwise all in good condition. The leaking stays in Main Boiler have been replaced by stays 2" larger in diameter. The wasted patch in the Donkey Boiler furnace has been renewed. On account of the condition of the Tail Shaft, in my opinion it should be again examined in twelve months time.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— This vessel's Machinery is now in safe condition & in our opinion the vessel is eligible for record L.M.C. 1-95 Subject to the Tail Shaft being again examined within twelve months.
