As far as seen, this vessel appears to be in an efficient condition, & in my opinion, is eligible to remain as classed, without record of survey.

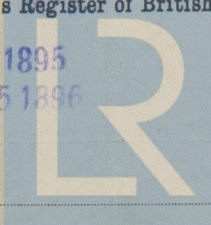
