In anticipation of the S.S No 1 now due, the fore and after peaks examined inside also the Bridge Deck Bunkers. which were cleaned, scaled and recoated. The masts spars rigging examined aloft.
To complete this survey. the vessel to be placed in dry dock the holds and Bunkers to be cleared also & TB space. ceiling lifted as required by Rules, & Ballast tanks tested. The pumps, sluices, pumps TWT. doors examined & the cement examined all fore and aft. between the peak bulkheads. The owners correspondingly advised
