REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Repairs of damage through stress of weather and Part Special Survey 2=1.*

Vessel placed in dry dock, rudder lifted, one pintle and the rudder stop renewed and one pintle renewed. The steering gear overhauled and put in good order and the stuffing box repaired with a keyed clamp. About 40 rivets in back of rudder renewed.

On Starboard side:— Six bulwark plates renewed and one cut out fairied and refitted. Main rail renewed from fore to main rigging and angle iron to same fairied in place; the topgallant rail in same range repaired and refitted and one length of angle iron fairied and refitted. Ten bulwark stanchions renewed & repaired and refitted, cement in gutter waterway made good, fittings on main rail & bulwarks in way of above repairs replaced.

and made good as before.

Ten chain plates to main rigging cut out repaired & refitted & two deadeyes renewed.

On Port side: - Three bulwark plates abreast foremast hatch faired in place as far as possible and additionally stiffened with 11 wide straps in way of bulwark stanchions and 11 stanchions repaired and refitted, cement in gutter waterway made good and main rail amidships refastened.

The forward boat's skids and stanchions repaired & the two forward boats renewed. The after boat's skids renewed and the stanchions to same repaired & refitted. The two after boats repaired.

The front bulkhead of poop repaired with a staple knee and a short length of angle bar at Port and Starboard quarters.

The after shroud of main rigging on starboard side and two inner jib guys renewed.

Part S.S. 2<sup>o</sup> 1.

Vessel placed in dry dock bottom examined cleaned and painted, two pintles of rudder renewed and the traces retouched.

The fore peak examined and the sea cock to head pump removed, a doubling plate fitted to shell in way of same and fastenings renewed.

Masts spars and rigging overhauled and examined. The following repairs require to be done to same.

Fore topgallant backstay, main cap shroud on S<sup>th</sup> side, main topmast, sprinker boom, gaff and foreseams all to renew. The shackles links and bolts of bobstay and bowsprit shrouds to be overhauled and renewed as necessary. Chafing battens to be fitted to the fore topmast & topgallant masts.

The fore and main lower keel trees found fractured & require to be repaired.

Coaming of main hatchway raised to 36" above deck by riveting new plates  $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick to the original coaming plates and two deep web plates fitted to this hatch.

To complete S.S. 2<sup>o</sup> 1: - With the exception of the examination in dry dock, the examination of fore peak & of masts spars and rigging the whole of the survey remains to be done, and the above repairs carried out.
