Whenever the replacement of Anchors, Chains, or Hawsers is reported, the particulars of weight or size and test of the articles should be clearly stated, and also the weight or size, &c., required by the Rules, together with the vessel's Equipment letter, if any. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.
