*Holds, plates, brackets, and under engine and boilers cleared, all close ceiling removed, and the cement, floors, frames, plating re examined, and the surface of the steel chipped, cleaned and recast throughout, the plating examined under sidelights, after plate tank examined and tested; pumps, sluices re examined, masts and rigging overhauled; The plating being found good it was not thought necessary to drill the same;
 Stow done on account of heavy, 14 deck plates cut out and removed, and two other plates doubled over. In the starboard bunker six new reverse bars fitted from keel to deck, and new face plates fitted to the web frames, and in the port bunker six new reverse bars fitted. Mast wedges removed, new fore stay fitted, and rigging lifted and reset.*


