Précis of particulars of Casualty
Vessel was in collision in the Lower Hope near Gravesend on 18th Decr. She was run ashore but slipped off & sank. The reports state that at low water on 18th December she was lying on her starboard broadside with portside awash.

The Salvage Association states that the Thames Conservancy have the case in hand

The usual notice has not been sent to the Owners in this case but as the vessel is submerged the circumstances are submitted for the Committee's consideration.

The shipping gazette received this morning (23/12/96) states that a steamer ran on to the sunken vessel on Saturday last and remained 6 1/2 hours before getting away.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

WINSLOE (s).—Gravesend, Dec. 18, 8 43 a.m.—Steamer Winsloe, for Rotterdam, is reported sunk in Lower Hope.
WINSLOE (s).—Gravesend, Dec. 18, 10 55 a.m.—Steamer Winsloe, of London, for Rotterdam, collided at 3 10 this morning in Lower Hope during fog with a steamer at anchor, name unknown. The Winsloe was struck on port side near main rigging and was run ashore, but she slipped off and sank; crew saved, and have just landed here in their own boats.
WINSLOE (s).—Gravesend, Dec. 18, 7 30 p.m.—At low water this evening steamer Winsloe was lying on her starboard broadside with portside awash.—[See issue of yesterday.]
WINSLOE (s).—Gravesend, Dec. 19, 8 32 a.m.—Steamer Mimi was the vessel with which the Winsloe collided yesterday morning.

JAMES CAMERON (s).—Gravesend, Dec. 19, 1 32 p.m.—Collier steamer James Cameron, outward bound, is reported to have run on the sunken steamer Winsloe at 3 o'clock this morning, and floated off at 9 30 without assistance, and proceeded.

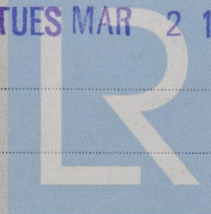
