Precis of particulars of Casualty

Vessel was in collision near Gravesend on 18th December. She was run ashore but slipped off & sank. The next day a steamer ran on her whilst sunk and remained 6 1/2 hours before floating off.

Vessel was raised on 4th Jan and taken to the Tilbury Docks.


On the last occasion when this case was before the Classing Committee it was decided to refer it to the General Committee. The General Committee on 11th Feb. ordered action to be deferred.

The Owners now verbally state that they have come to a settlement with the Underwriters; that the vessel has been placed in graving dock today; & that she will be repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.
