Précis of particulars of Casualty

Vessel was in collision near *Gravesend* on 18th Dec^r. She was run ashore but slipped off & sank. The next day a steamer ran on to her whilst sunk and remained 6 1/2 hours before floating off.

On 23rd Dec^r the Owners wrote asking that the case be deferred.

The vessel was lifted on 4th Jan.

Mr. Cooper, Principal Surveyor for the London District is informed that the vessel is in Tilbury dock. He understands that the Owners have abandoned the vessel to the Underwriters and that she will probably be taken to some Dutch port. No final decision appears to have been arrived at.

On enquiry of the Owners this morning (12/1/97 Tuesday), it is found that the vessel is to be discharged and docked for survey in London within two or three days. Provisional estimates received for repairs appear to indicate that the vessel is worth the expense, and the present intention is to carry out the necessary work. The results of the examination of the vessel's bottom in dry dock may of course modify this intention.

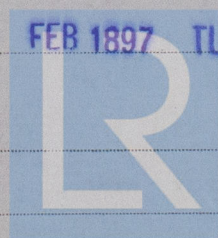
