SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

Vessel was in collision near Gravesend on 18th Decr. She was run ashore but slipped off & sank. The next day a steamer ran on her whilst sunk and remained 6 1/2 hours before floating off.

On 23rd Decr the Owners wrote asking that the case be deferred.

The vessel was lifted on 4th Jan. On 12th Jan. the Owners stated that the vessel would probably be repaired, and the Committee decided to defer action for a month.

The Owners state today that they hope to come to a settlement with the Underwriters in a short time, and that there is no doubt the vessel will be repaired.
