Details of particulars of Casualty

Vessel was sunk by collision whilst lying loaded at the buoys off Woolwich on 26th March.

The usual notice has not been sent to the Owners in this case but as the vessel appears to be submerged the circumstances are submitted for the Committee's instructions thereon.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

ALBERTINA (s).—*Blackwall*, March 26, 7 9 a.m.—At 3 35 a.m., as the steamer *Albertina*, of Newcastle, loaded coal, was proceeding up river off Arsenal Bank, Woolwich, she collided with the steamer *Sir Galahad*, of London, loaded, lying at the Gallions buoys, doing considerable damage to the latter vessel's starboard side and sinking the same. No lives lost.

ALBERTINA (s).—*Gravesend*, March 26, 12 3 p.m.—The steamer that sunk the *Sir Galahad* was the *Albertina*, from Goole for Waddel's Wharf. Latter vessel is apparently uninjured.

ALBERTINA (s).—*North Woolwich*, March 26, 9 54 a.m.—Steamer *Albertina*, passing through Gallions Reach at 5 a.m. this morning, collided with steamer "*Svengalia*," lying at Gallion Buoys, sinking the "*Svengalia*;" crew saved.
