This vessel now appears to be in good & efficient condition & is eligible in my opinion to remain as classed with record of survey 1,98

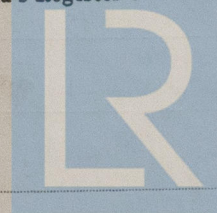
